

CHAPTER 410

Private Water Systems

EDITOR'S NOTE: Chapter 410 was replaced by Resolution 4-81 adopted January 13, 1981. Under authority of ORC 3701.33 through 3701.35, the Summit County Board of Health administers and enforces those provisions of OAC 3701-28-01 through 3701-28-21 pertaining to private water systems. This responsibility includes issuing permits; establishing sampling fees; registering water haulers; inspecting sites; sampling water wells; and all other acts or efforts necessary to assure compliance with the requirements of private water systems law and regulations. The private water systems law and regulations are published by the Ohio Department of Health, copies of which are available for distribution by the Summit County Board of Health.

There are no sections in Chapter 410. This chapter has been established to provide a place for cross references and any future legislation.
