#### 1020. 01 PERMIT REQUIRED; SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION; FEE.

(a) No person shall engage in the collection and removal, for remuneration, of swill, garbage, rubbish, refuse or offal in the Health District until a permit therefor is obtained from the Board of Health. The permit shall state the conditions under which the material shall be removed and disposed of.

(b) Permits issued under this section may be suspended or revoked at any time at the discretion of the Health Commissioner for a violation of any Board of Health regulation or State law pertaining to the collection, transporting and disposal of waste materials. Any person whose permit has been suspended or revoked may make a written request for a hearing before the Board of Health of the Health District. The Board of Health shall grant such hearing within a reasonable time after a request is made therefor.

(c) No person shall engage in the business of collection and removal and/or disposal, for remuneration, of swill, garbage, rubbish, offal or refuse, in the Health District without first paying an annual permit fee as set forth in Section 220. 04 of the Administration Code for each truck or conveyance having approved equipment for performance of such service, and without first submitting an application on a form prescribed and provided by the Health Department.

#### 1020.02 DISPLAY OF PERMIT NUMBER.

The permit number shall be provided on the sides of the garbage and refuse trucks and shall be at least four inches in size.

#### 1020.03 REQUIREMENTS FOR VEHICLES.

(a) The body of the truck or conveyance which is to be used for transportation of garbage shall be of easily cleanable material, nonabsorbant, waterproof, watertight and made of metal. The bed of the truck shall be bent to a three-inch rise in height for the entire end of the truck, or other means shall be provided to prevent leakage of liquids out of the truck. The contents of the truck shall be properly covered at all times when such vehicle is in motion. All truck bodies shall be kept clean and in a sanitary condition at all times.

(b) The bed of the truck or conveyance which is to be used for transportation of ashes, refuse and other waste material shall be easily cleanable and the waste shall be properly covered.

#### 1020.04 DISPOSAL OF CONTENTS.

All garbage and refuse shall be disposed of in an approved solid waste disposal site or other location approved by the Health Commissioner.

#### 1020.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this Environmental Health Code shall be in violation of ORC 3707.48, 3709.20, 3709.21 or 3709.22, and subject to penalties provided in ORC 3707.99 and 3709.99.
