

## CHAPTER 1050

### Construction and Demolition Debris

EDITOR'S NOTE: Chapter 1050 was established by Resolution 156-02 adopted June 13, 2002. Under authority of ORC 3734.01 through 3734.99, the Summit County Board of Health administers and enforces those provisions of OAC 3745-37-01 through 3745-37-15 and OAC 3745-400-01 through 3745-400-15 pertaining to construction and demolition debris. This responsibility includes plan approval, licensing, inspecting sites and facilities, and all other acts or efforts necessary to assure compliance with the requirements of construction and demolition debris disposal law and regulations. The construction and demolition debris law and regulations are published by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA), copies of which are available through the OEPA.

There are no sections in Chapter 1050. This chapter has been established to provide a place for cross references and any future legislation.
