

CHAPTER 2220

Semipublic Sewage Disposal Systems

EDITOR'S NOTE: Chapter 2220 was established by Resolution 156-02 adopted June 13, 2002. Under authority of Amended House Bill 110 (March 1, 1984) which amended ORC 3709.085 and ORC 6111.01, the Summit County Board of Health entered into a contract (July 1, 1985) with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) to provide, on the behalf of the OEPA, inspection and enforcement services to control water pollution from septic tanks and semipublic sewage disposal systems and to establish and collect inspection fees. The *Guide for Owners of Package Extended Aeration Sewage Treatment Plants* and the *Guide for On-site Sewage Disposal Systems (Septic Tank / Tile Field Systems)* are published by the OEPA, copies of which are available for distribution by the Summit County Board of Health.

There are no sections in Chapter 2220. This chapter has been established to provide a place for cross references and any future legislation.
