

CHAPTER 2240

Schools

EDITOR'S NOTE: Chapter 2240 was established by Resolution 156-02 adopted June 13, 2002. Under authority of ORC 3707.03(Correction of nuisance or unsanitary conditions on school property) and 3707.27(Board shall inspect schools and may close them), the Summit County Board of Health will make written recommendations to the board of education, school board, or other person responsible for the school property. This responsibility includes, inspecting at least twice a year, investigating complaints, and all other acts or efforts necessary to assure sanitary conditions are maintained on school property . *A Handbook for Public Playground Safety* is published by The US Consumer Products Safety Commission and the *School Sanitation Program Review Guideline* is published by the Environmental Health Division of the Summit County Combined General Health District, copies of which are available for distribution by the County of Summit Board of Health.
